WHEREAS, earlier in the day, the Rappahannock High School players defeated another talented doubles tennis team; Lori Gagnon and Taylor Yeatman won a three-set match against Auburn High School to advance to the state championship final; and

WHEREAS, the girls' tennis team from Rappahannock High School is ably coached by Marian Walker and Jackie Morris; the doubles champions—and the entire team—were supported throughout the season by their fellow students and the Rappahannock High School community; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED by the Senate, the House of Delegates concurring, That the General Assembly hereby commend the Rappahannock High School girls' doubles tennis team, consisting of Lori Gagnon and Taylor Yeatman, for winning the 2015 Virginia High School League Group 1A state championship; and, be it
