Commending Mechanicsville American Legion Post 175.

WHEREAS, Mechanicsville American Legion Post 175 supports veterans affairs, facilitates rehabilitation of veterans, promotes patriotism and national security, and empowers local young people to become leaders in the community; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED by the Senate of Virginia, That Mechanicsville American Legion Post 175 hereby be commended on the occasion of its 70th anniversary; and, be it

RESOLVED FURTHER, That the Clerk of the Senate prepare a copy of this resolution for presentation to Mechanicsville American Legion Post 175 as an expression of the Senate of Virginia's admiration for the post's service to the Mechanicsville community and veterans throughout the Commonwealth and the United States.
