3. Committee: Passed both houses.

4. Title: Institutions of higher education; law-enforcement agencies; response to sexual assault.

5. Summary: The bill permits each public and private institution of higher education to request the cooperation of the local law enforcement agency to establish a memorandum of understanding with such law enforcement agency to address the prevention of and response to sexual assault, and requires the primary law enforcement agency of each locality to cooperate in the establishment of such memoranda as requested.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

7. No Fiscal Impact: Final. See item 8.

8. Fiscal Implications: Institutions of higher education are currently required to enter into mutual aid agreements with local or state law enforcement for investigations of sexual assault and death on campus. Memoranda of understanding between institutions of higher education and local or state law enforcement to address the prevention of and response to sexual assault can likely be implemented at no additional cost within the existing framework.
