4.	Title:	Virginia Residential Property Disclosure Act; representations related to covenants and restrictions.

5. Summary: Provides that, in delivering the residential property disclosure statement to a prospective purchaser of residential property under the Virginia Residential Property Disclosure Act, the owner makes no representations with respect to any covenants and restrictions that may be recorded in land records that affect the real property or any improvements located on the property or zoning classification; permitted uses of adjacent parcels; or costs associated with maintaining, repairing, or inspecting any wastewater system, including any costs or requirements related to the pump-out of septic tanks. The bill also replaces a reference to "certified home inspection" with "home inspection," relating to a prospective purchaser's exercise of due diligence. The bill's second enactment requires the Virginia Housing Commission to study the provisions of the Virginia Residential Property Disclosure Act to determine if the required disclosures could be consolidated or otherwise addressed in a more comprehensive way.
