4. Title: Blind and Vision Impaired, Department for the; contracts for operation of certain vending machines

Summary: The enrolled bill provides that the Department of General Services must conduct the procurement process for contracts for goods or services authorized by the Department for the Blind and Vision Impaired, including (i) preparing the solicitation document that will be used, (ii) the evaluating of responses to the issued solicitation, and (iii) making the award decision on the basis of the final scoring of bids or proposals. In addition, the bill contains an enactment clause that the bill's provisions should not be construed to affect any litigation pending as of January 1, 2016.
