**4. Title:** Veterans Services Foundation.

**5. Summary:** The bill distinguishes between members and trustees of the Veteran Services Foundation (VSF) by providing that the membership shall consist of the board of trustees, supporting staff, donors, volunteers, and other interested parties. The bill also requires that there be a balanced representation among the armed services on the board of trustees. Finally, the bill designates the Director of Finance for the Department of Veterans Services as the treasurer of the Foundation.
