3. Committee: Agriculture, Chesapeake and Natural Resources

4. Title: Control of gas emission from certain landfills.

5. Summary: Requires all active sanitary landfills that hold a Title V operating permit issued by the Virginia Air Pollution Control Board and are located within one-half mile of any residence or residentially zoned property to install a landfill gas collection and control system by July 1, 2018, whether or not the Title V operating permit requires such installation. The bill also requires any application for the expansion of any such landfill to include certification from the governing body of the locality where the facility is located that the expansion of the facility has been approved.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Preliminary.

8. Fiscal Implications: Title V of the federal Clean Air Act requires major sources of air pollutants, and certain other sources, to obtain and operate in compliance with an operating permit. According to the Department of Environmental Quality, this bill is not anticipated to result in a state fiscal impact.
