3. Committee: Courts of Justice

4. Title: Lobbyist reporting; disclosure of certain persons attending entertainment events prohibited.

5. Summary: The engrossed bill makes it optional to list the name of a legislative or executive official, or a member of his immediate family, who attends a reportable entertainment event from being disclosed by the principal if that legislative or executive official reimburses the principal for, or otherwise pays for, his attendance, or the attendance of a member of his immediate family, at the entertainment event. The reimbursement considered in this situation is to be calculated using the average value for each person attending the event. The engrossed bill also adds an emergency clause to make the bill effective upon passage.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: None.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: No fiscal impact.

8. Fiscal Implications: The engrossed bill does not present a fiscal impact to the Commonwealth.
