5. Summary: Repeals provisions that prescribe the content of tributary plans as part of the tributary strategies. Tributary strategies have been replaced by Watershed Implementation Plans (WIP).

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Final.

8. Fiscal Implications: The 2015 Session of the General Assembly repealed the requirement that the Secretary of Natural Resources report annually on Chesapeake Bay tributary plans. In addition, the tributary plans were replaced by the Watershed Implementation Plan. It is anticipated that this bill will not result in a state fiscal impact to state agencies.
