3. Committee: Militia, Police and Public Safety

4. Title: Justifiable homicide; reporting requirement of State Police.

5. Summary: The substitute proposal requires the State Police to include justifiable homicides involving a law-enforcement officer in the annual Crime in Virginia report. The bill clarifies justifiable homicide as officer-involved shootings defined in Code of Virginia § 9.1-101, that results in the death or serious bodily injury of another. The bill also requires any law-enforcement or public safety officer required to report such homicides to receive training concerning such reporting requirement.

8. Fiscal Implications: The proposal has no material fiscal impact on the Department of State Police. The impact on local law enforcement agencies is indeterminate.
