**4. Title:** Virginia Freedom of Information Act (FOIA); public access to certain criminal investigative files.

**5. Summary:** Limits the application of the exemption for criminal investigative files to active criminal investigative files. As a result, closed or inactive criminal investigative files would be subject to mandatory disclosure, if requested.

**6. Budget Amendment Necessary:** No.

**7. Fiscal Impact Estimates:** No fiscal impact.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** Since agencies may assess reasonable charges for the cost incurred in supplying records (§ 2.2-3704.F), potential increased FOIA requests as a result of this bill should not produce a material fiscal impact.
