4. Title: Commission on Economic Opportunity for Virginians in Aspiring and Diverse Communities; report.

5. Summary: The bill establishes, subject to appropriation in the 2016 general appropriation act, a 12-member legislative Commission on Economic Opportunity for Virginians in Aspiring and Diverse Communities (the Commission) to determine the need for and ways to achieve economic opportunities for members of aspiring and diverse communities in Virginia. The bill provides that the Commission sunsets on July 1, 2019.

8. Fiscal Implications: The fiscal impact of this bill primarily involves the costs associated with meetings and staff support. The Senate of Virginia anticipates that their portion of meeting costs each year will be approximately \$4,720, while the House of Delegates costs are approximately \$5,840. These costs are based on the 6 legislative members attending an assumed four meetings, the average number of meetings a commission of this nature usually involves. In regards to staffing and support costs, the Senate, the House, and the Division of Legislative Services expect support costs to be minimal and absorbed within existing appropriations.
