4. Title: Middle Peninsula Chesapeake Bay Public Access Authority Act.

5. Summary: Middle Peninsula Chesapeake Bay Public Access Authority Act. Grants the Middle Peninsula Chesapeake Bay Public Access Authority the power to request and accept legal advice and assistance from the Office of the Attorney General.
