3. Committee: Passed the House.

4. Title: Warrantless arrest; conservation police officers and conservation officers.

5. Summary: This bill allows a law-enforcement officer to make warrantless arrests for misdemeanors not committed in the officer's presence involving (i) reckless handling of a firearm; (ii) trespass on property where hunting, trapping, or fishing has been prohibited; or (iii) killing deer by use of certain lights when any such arrest is based on probable cause upon personal investigation.
