4. Title: Local school boards; public school choice.

5. Summary: Requires, notwithstanding any agreement, waiver from the federal government, or provision of law to the contrary, each local school board to provide all students enrolled in a public school in the school division that is identified by the Commonwealth for comprehensive support and improvement under relevant federal law with the option to transfer to another public school in the school division.

8. Fiscal Implications: This bill does not change how school divisions are funded and no students would attend a school outside of the division in which they reside as a result of this bill. Consequently, there is no anticipated state fiscal impact from this legislation.
