3. Committee: Health, Welfare and Institutions.

4. Title: Confidentiality of certain information obtained by health regulatory boards in proceedings.

5. Summary: Provides that in cases involving allegations that a practitioner is unable to practice with reasonable skill and safety to patients because of excessive use of alcohol or drugs or physical or mental illness, the health regulatory board may deem information related to (i) health services received by the practitioner as defined in §32.1-127.1:03, (ii) information derived from the health records, as defined in § 32.1-127.1:03, or (iii) any finding of fact that may indicate the practitioner's physical or mental illness confidential and include such information in a confidential exhibit to a notice or order that shall not be disclosed to the public.
