4. Title: Ownership of service facilities; exemptions

5. Summary: This bill allows a manufacturer of engines for trucks having a gross vehicle weight rating of more than 7,500 pounds to own a service facility.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Preliminary. See Item #8.

8. Fiscal Implications: There is the potential for an expenditure impact at the Department of Motor Vehicles in conducting administrative franchise hearings alleging violations of *Va. Code* § 46.2-1572.1 by manufacturers of certain truck engines. The number of hearings that may be required cannot be reliably estimated. However, the agency expects the number of such hearings, if any, to be very low. The Motor Vehicle Dealer Board anticipates no impact on that agency.
