Summary:** Provides that any program for the participation of small, women-owned, minority-owned, and service disabled veteran-owned businesses or any enhancement or remedial measures authorized by the Governor that includes the participation of microbusinesses in public procurement shall include a provision that in the event a micro-business fails to be awarded a contract, such contract remains subject to the set-aside award priority for qualified small businesses and businesses owned by women, minorities, and service disabled veterans and certified by the Department of Small Business and Supplier Diversity.

- **8. Fiscal Implications:** No state fiscal impact is expected, as the bill is consistent with current practices. Under current practice, if no certified micro-business is available or the price is not considered fair and reasonable, the procuring state agency will proceed to the next low certified small business and will award to them if the price is considered fair and reasonable.
