**4. Title:** Alcoholic beverage control; farm wineries and limited brewery licenses; land zoned agricultural

**5. Summary:** Clarifies that for farm wineries, or limited breweries "on land zoned agricultural" means land zoned as an agricultural district, or classification that permits agricultural use. It further clarifies that "land zoned agricultural" does not include residential conservation and nothing else in the definition "land zoned agricultural" limits or affects local zoning authority.
