4. Title: Alcoholic beverage control; limited mixed beverage license for retail cigar shops

5. Summary: Creates a new limited mixed beverage license for retail cigar shops. The bill sets out the privileges of this new license, including that in no event shall the sale of any alcoholic beverages exceed 50 percent of the total annual gross sales of the cigar shop. The bill also defines cigar shop and sets out the state and local license taxes for this license.
