5.	<b>Summary:</b> This bill includes immediate family members of persons who have died while in the performance of their official duties in the Army, Navy, Air Force, Marines, and Coast Guard, as well as those in an Army Reserve or Guard unit in a drill status, among those who may be issued a special license plate known as the "Next of Kin" license plate.

8.	<b>Fiscal Implications:</b> This legislation will create a new special license plate. The number of individuals that would be eligible for the new special plate cannot accurately be determined. The Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) incurs a cost of approximately \$3 for each standard plate produced. This special plate does not include the one-time \$10 fee. The purchasers of the special plates will pay as much as they would if they got a standard passenger plate, for which DMV recoups the \$3 cost from the traditional fees customers pay. The agency will absorb the cost differential between the production of the standard plate and the production of the special plate. Consequently, the issuance of new plates will not lead to increased revenue for the Commonwealth.
