4. Title: Voter registration; required information on application form.

5. Summary: Specifies in greater detail the information that applicants for voter registration are required to provide on the voter registration application form. The bill also requires the general registrars to deny the application of any applicant who fails to provide his first and last name, date of birth, social security number or indicate that he does not have a social security number; citizenship status or provides that he is not a U.S. citizen; residence address or indicate rural residence location or homelessness; felony conviction and restoration of voting rights; adjudications of mental incapacity and disqualification to vote; previous voter registration information or indicate lack thereof; or indicate that he will not be; at least 18 years of age on or before the date of the next general election.
