**4. Title:** Virginia Public Procurement Act; Request for Proposals for architectural or engineering services.

**5. Summary:** Provides that in the case of the selection process for a Request for Proposals for architectural or engineering services, the public body shall not request or require offerors to list any exceptions to proposed contractual terms and conditions until after the qualified offerors are ranked.

The substitute bill provides that the above requirement shall apply unless such terms and conditions are required by statute, regulation, ordinance, or standards developed pursuant to § 2.2-1132, Code of Virginia.

**7. Fiscal Impact Estimates:** No state fiscal impact. See Item 8, below.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** No state fiscal impact is expected, as the bill is consistent with the current practices of state agencies and institutions subject to the Virginia Public Procurement Act.
