4. Title: Organ donation; indication consent to remain on driver's license.

5. Summary: This bill eliminates the requirement that a person indicate his willingness to make an anatomical gift every time he renews or replaces his license.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Preliminary. See Item #8.

8. Fiscal Implications: A one-time cost of \$20,790 is anticipated in order to change Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) online transactions to comply with this bill. Since the staff hours required to implement this can be accomplished during the normal work schedules for DMV employees, the agency is able to absorb this cost.

9. Specific Agency or Political Subdivisions Affected: Department of Motor Vehicles.
