3. Committee: Militia, Police and Public Safety

4. Title: Concealed handgun permits; reciprocity with other states.

5. Summary: The substitute legislation requires the General Assembly, in consultation with the Attorney General, to determine whether states meet the requirement and qualifications for Virginia to recognize the concealed handgun permit of a person from another state. The list is to be communicated to the Department of State Police, which is to maintain the list and enter into agreements for reciprocal recognition with any state qualifying for recognition.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Preliminary. See Item 8.

8. Fiscal Implications: According to the comments received from the General Assembly staff on the substitute bill, the fiscal impact on the House of Delegates and the Senate is indeterminate. The proposal has no impact on the Department of State Police.
