4. Title: Use of room segregation in juvenile detention homes and juvenile correctional facilities

5. Summary: Requires the Board of Juvenile Justice to consult with experts in the fields of mental health and juvenile justice and child-rights advocates to promulgate regulations on the use of room segregation in juvenile detention homes and juvenile correctional facilities. The bill provides that the Board of Juvenile Justice is to publish proposed regulations, and clarification of regulations on the use of room segregation in juvenile correctional facilities and juvenile detention homes existing prior to the effective date of this act by July 1, 2017.
