## 5. Summary:

The Code of Virginia directs the Governor to submit annually to the General Assembly a bill proposing amendments to the Commonwealth's Six-Year Capital Outlay Plan. The proposed legislation would establish a new six-year capital outlay plan and repeal the one currently in effect. The list of capital projects consists primarily of projects that have been authorized for planning. It does not include any projects that have already been approved for construction or are recommended for construction in the Governor's introduced budget bill.
