4. Title: Recreational oyster harvest.

5. Summary: Limits the exemption for taking up to one bushel of oysters for personal use on Sunday to those (i) Sundays within the legally prescribed public oyster harvest season; and (ii) public oyster grounds or unleased bottom that have been designated as open for harvest.
