3. Committee: General Laws

4. Title: Department of Veterans Services; Virginia War Memorial Division; names and homes of record.

5. Summary: The bill clarifies that Virginians Killed in Action as a result of military operations against terrorism in a U.S. Department of Defense designated combat zone under honorable conditions shall be included on the Shrine of Memory at the Virginia War Memorial. The bill also requires that the names and homes of record designation of those Virginians Killed in Action be placed on the Virginia War Memorial within one year of the date of death.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: None.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Preliminary.

8. Fiscal Implications: An expansion project is underway at the Virginia War Memorial to include the Shrine of Memory. This will allow the Department of Veterans Services (DVS) to include the names and homes of record designation of Virginians killed in action to the specifications of the legislation. Once the expansion to the Shrine is complete, the agency expects that they will be able to add any new names to the memorial within one year as specified in the bill with existing resources.

9. Specific Agency or Political Subdivisions Affected: Department of Veterans Services.

10. Technical Amendment Necessary: None.

11. Other Comments: Although the effective date of the legislation is July 1, 2016, the expansion at the Virginia War Memorial is not anticipated to be complete until Fall 2017.
