3. Committee: Passed the Senate.

4. Title: Black vultures; killing not prohibited by state law.

5. Summary: This substitute bill authorizes the Commissioner of the Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services to enter into agreements with local and state agencies for the control of the black vulture (*Coragyps atratus*) and other wildlife that pose a danger to agricultural animals. The bill authorizes the Commissioner to work with the federal government to establish and maintain the Virginia Cooperative Wildlife Damage Management Program, formerly referred to as the Virginia Cooperative Coyote Damage Control Program.
