3. Committee: Privileges and Elections

4. Title: Voter registration; notification to other states of a person's registration in Virginia.

5. Summary: Requires the general registrars, when registering any person who was previously registered in another state, to notify the appropriate authority in that state of the person's registration in Virginia by providing, through the Department of Elections, an electronic copy of that person's registration application.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: Indeterminate – see Item 8.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Preliminary – see Item 8.

8. Fiscal Implications: According to the Department of Elections, the state fiscal impact of the proposed legislation cannot be determined at this time. The proposed legislation may require one-time medium configuration changes to the Virginia Election and Registration Information System (VERIS). However, any changes to VERIS would depend on the annual number of new registered voters in Virginia who were previously registered in another state.
