3. Committee: Passed Both Houses

4. Title: Mobile food vending in commuter lots in Planning District 8; fees; security cameras.

5. Summary: Allows mobile food vending units to apply for a permit and pay a fee to the Department of Transportation that would allow them to sell food in commuter lots in Planning District 8. The bill requires the Department to establish criteria for the program and a fee for the permit and to publish the permit application form and the established fee for the permit on its website.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Final. See Item 8.

8. Fiscal Implications: Any costs incurred by the Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) associated with permit issuance and enforcement could be absorbed within VDOT's existing budget.

Until the permit fees are established and the number of permits issued is known, it is not possible to estimate how much in revenue might be generated.
