3. Committee: General Laws and Technology

4. Title: Virginia Information Technologies Agency; utilization of service disabled veteran businesses.

5. Summary: Requires every state agency to include as a component of any small business enhancement measure implemented by the Governor pursuant to subsection B of § 2.2-4310 of the *Code of Virginia* a requirement for a minimum of three percent utilization of service disabled veteran businesses as defined in § 2.2-2001 of the *Code of Virginia*.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Indeterminate, see item 8.

8. Fiscal Implications: This bill requires all state agencies, as a component of any small business enhancement measure implemented by the Governor pursuant to subsection B of § 2.2-4310 of the *Code of Virginia*, to include a requirement that each agency utilize a minimum of three percent of service disabled veteran businesses. Changes in utilization requirements may impact agency costs due to such factors as availability of qualified businesses, however, such impacts are currently indeterminate.

9. Specific Agency or Political Subdivisions Affected: All state agencies

10. Technical Amendment Necessary: No.

11. Other Comments: The engrossed version of this bill sets the utilization requirement at three percent and applies to all state agencies. The bill as introduced set the utilization requirement at five percent and applied only to the Virginia Information Technologies Agency.
