3. Committee: General Laws

4. Title: State agencies; utilization of service disabled veteran businesses.

5. Summary: Requires that state agency goals created under § 2.2-4310 also include a goal of a minimum of three percent participation by service disabled veteran businesses as defined in § 2.2-2001 and 2.2-4310 of the *Code of Virginia* when contracting for information technology goods and services.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Indeterminate, see item 8.

8. Fiscal Implications: This bill requires all state agencies, as part of the goals each creates under § 2.2-4310 of the *Code of Virginia*, to include a goal of a minimum of three percent participation by service disabled veteran businesses when contracting for information technology goods and services. Changes in utilization requirements may impact agency costs due to such factors as availability of qualified businesses, however, such impacts are currently indeterminate.
