**4. Title:** Alcoholic beverage control; limited brewery licenses

**5. Summary:** Provides that for a limited brewery license, "land zoned agricultural" means land zoned as an agricultural district or classification or any classification that permits agricultural use and has been designated by local ordinance as eligible for a limited brewery license. Land zoned agricultural does not include land zoned "residential conservation." Except for the limitation on land zoned "residential conservation," nothing in this definition shall otherwise limit or affect local zoning authority.
