**4. Title:** Alcoholic beverage control; limited distiller's licenses

**5. Summary:** Provides that for a limited distiller's license, "land zoned agricultural" means land zoned as an agricultural district or classification or any classification that permits agricultural use and has been designated by local ordinance for a limited distiller's license. Except for the limitation on land zoned "residential conservation," nothing in this definition shall otherwise limit or affect local zoning authority.
