3. Committee: Education and Health

4. Title: Nurse practitioners.

5. Summary: Eliminates the requirement that a nurse practitioner practice as part of a patient care team with a practice agreement with a patient care physician. The bill also eliminates a Board of Health pilot program authorizing certain nurse practitioners to practice without a practice agreement as the bill makes such pilot obsolete. The bill requires regulations to be promulgated within 280 days of enactment.

8. Fiscal Implications: This bill would not have a fiscal impact on the Commonwealth. The bill eliminates requirements for nurse practitioners and requires the board to promulgate regulations; this will not impact the agency or its operations.
