4. Title: Lobbyist reporting; disclosure of certain persons attending entertainment events prohibited.

5. Summary: The bill prohibits the name of a legislative or executive official, or a member of his immediate family, who attends a reportable entertainment event from being disclosed by the principal if that legislative or executive official reimburses the principal for, or otherwise pays for, his attendance, or the attendance of a member of his immediate family, at the entertainment event. Reimbursement shall be calculated using the average value for each person attending the event.

8. Fiscal Implications: The bill does not present a fiscal impact to the Commonwealth.
