**4. Title:** Alcoholic beverage control; farm winery license

**5. Summary:** Allows Class A farm winery licensees to trade fruits or agricultural products grown or produced on such farms with other farm winery licensees and provides that such fruit or agricultural products shall be considered to be grown or produced on the receiving farm for the purposes of meeting the requirement that at least 51 percent of the fruits or agricultural products used by a Class A farm winery licensee to manufacture wine shall be grown or produced on such farm.
