5. Summary: The proposed legislation directs the Department of Medical Assistance Services to issue a Request for Proposal for statewide nonemergency medical transportation services as soon as reliable rate setting is available, in order to enter a new contract by January 1, 2017.

8. Fiscal Implications: The agency estimates that the bill would move up the timeframe for re-procuring statewide nonemergency medical transportation services by approximately nine months.
