HOUSE BILL NO. 1525

AMENDMENT IN THE NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE

(Proposed by the Joint Conference Committee

on February 25, 2017)

(Patron Prior to Substitute—Delegate Albo)

A BILL to amend the Code of Virginia by adding a section numbered 46.2-410.2, relating to revocation or suspension of driver's licenses; laws of other jurisdictions.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

9 1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 46.2-410.2 as follows:

10 § 46.2-410.2. License suspension or revocation by Commissioner; offenses under the laws of other 11 jurisdictions.

12 Notwithstanding any other provision of this chapter, the Commissioner shall not administratively revoke or suspend the driver's license of any person on the basis of receiving a record of such person's 13 conviction for any offense under the laws of another jurisdiction that would otherwise require the 14 15 Commissioner to revoke or suspend such person's driver's license unless such offense is substantially 16 similar to an offense under the laws of the Commonwealth or a county, city, or town ordinance. 17 Whenever the Commissioner is required to determine whether the law of another jurisdiction is substantially similar to the laws of the Commonwealth, or a county, city, or town ordinance, such 18 determination shall be based only on the text of the other jurisdiction's law without reference to the 19 20 particular circumstances of any conviction under such other jurisdiction's laws. However, if the 21 Commissioner cannot reasonably determine from the text of the other jurisdiction's law whether such 22 law is substantially similar to the laws of the Commonwealth, or a county, city, or town ordinance, the 23 Commissioner may, if available, review a certified copy of the final order of the person's conviction in 24 order to make such determination. 25 2. That the Department of Motor Vehicles shall reinstate a person's driver's license that was

administratively revoked or suspended prior to July 1, 2017, by the Commissioner of the 26 Department of Motor Vehicles solely on the basis of receiving a record of such person's conviction 27 28 for any offense under the laws of another jurisdiction if, on a form promulgated by the 29 Department of Motor Vehicles, such person submits to the Department of Motor Vehicles a 30 request to review such suspension or revocation and the Department of Motor Vehicles determines 31 that such suspension or revocation was based on a conviction not in compliance with the 32 provisions of this act. The person requesting the review shall submit with the form a copy of the other jurisdiction's statute under which he was convicted that was in effect at the time of the conviction and a certified copy of the final order of conviction from the other jurisdiction. Any refusal by the Department of Motor Vehicles to reinstate a person's driver's license shall be 33 34 35 36 reviewable in accordance with the provisions of § 46.2-410.1 of the Code of Virginia. Nothing 37 herein shall require the Department of Motor Vehicles to reinstate a person's driver's license if 38 such license was otherwise suspended or revoked.
