VIRGINIA ACTS OF ASSEMBLY - CHAPTER

2 An Act to amend and reenact § 32.1-102.4 of the Code of Virginia, relating to conditions on certificates 3 of public need; alternative plans of compliance.

Approved

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia: 6

7 1. That § 32.1-102.4 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows: 8

§ 32.1-102.4. Conditions of certificates; monitoring; revocation of certificates.

9 A. A certificate shall be issued with a schedule for the completion of the project and a maximum 10 capital expenditure amount for the project. The schedule may not be extended and the maximum capital expenditure may not be exceeded without the approval of the Commissioner in accordance with the 11 12 regulations of the Board.

13 B. The Commissioner shall monitor each project for which a certificate is issued to determine its progress and compliance with the schedule and with the maximum capital expenditure. The 14 15 Commissioner shall also monitor all continuing care retirement communities for which a certificate is issued authorizing the establishment of a nursing home facility or an increase in the number of nursing 16 home beds pursuant to § 32.1-102.3:2 and shall enforce compliance with the conditions for such 17 applications which are required by § 32.1-102.3:2. Any willful violation of a provision of § 32.1-102.3:2 18 19 or conditions of a certificate of public need granted under the provisions of § 32.1-102.3:2 shall be subject to a civil penalty of up to \$100 per violation per day until the date the Commissioner determines 20 21 that such facility is in compliance. 22

C. A certificate may be revoked when:

23 1. Substantial and continuing progress towards completion of the project in accordance with the 24 schedule has not been made; 25

2. The maximum capital expenditure amount set for the project is exceeded;

26 3. The applicant has willfully or recklessly misrepresented intentions or facts in obtaining a 27 certificate; or

28 4. A continuing care retirement community applicant has failed to honor the conditions of a 29 certificate allowing the establishment of a nursing home facility or granting an increase in the number of 30 nursing home beds in an existing facility which was approved in accordance with the requirements of 31 § 32.1-102.3:2.

32 D. Further, the Commissioner shall not approve an extension for a schedule for completion of any 33 project or the exceeding of the maximum capital expenditure of any project unless such extension or 34 excess complies with the limitations provided in the regulations promulgated by the Board pursuant to 35 § 32.1-102.2.

36 E. Any person willfully violating the Board's regulations establishing limitations for schedules for 37 completion of any project or limitations on the exceeding of the maximum capital expenditure of any 38 project shall be subject to a civil penalty of up to \$100 per violation per day until the date of 39 completion of the project.

40 \vec{F} . The Commissioner may condition, pursuant to the regulations of the Board, the approval of a 41 certificate (i) upon the agreement of the applicant to provide a level of care at a reduced rate to 42 indigents or accept patients requiring specialized care or (ii) upon the agreement of the applicant to 43 facilitate the development and operation of primary medical care services in designated medically 44 underserved areas of the applicant's service area.

45 The certificate holder shall provide documentation to the Department demonstrating that the certificate holder has satisfied the conditions of the certificate. If the certificate holder is unable or fails 46 to satisfy the conditions of a certificate, the Department may approve alternative methods to satisfy the 47 conditions pursuant to a plan of compliance. The plan of compliance shall identify a timeframe within 48 49 which the certificate holder will satisfy the conditions of the certificate, and identify how the certificate 50 holder will satisfy the conditions of the certificate, which may include (i) making direct payments to an organization authorized under a memorandum of understanding with the Department to receive 51 contributions satisfying conditions of a certificate, (ii) making direct payments to a private nonprofit 52 53 foundation that funds basic insurance coverage for indigents authorized under a memorandum of 54 understanding with the Department to receive contributions satisfying conditions of a certificate, or (iii) 55 other documented efforts or initiatives to provide primary or specialized care to underserved populations. 56 In cases in which the certificate holder holds more than one certificate with conditions pursuant to this

57 subsection, and the certificate holder is unable to satisfy the conditions of one certificate, such plan of 58 compliance may provide for satisfaction of the conditions on that certificate by providing care at a 59 reduced rate to indigent individuals in excess of the amount required by another certificate issued to the 60 same holder, in an amount approved by the Department provided such care is offered at the same 61 facility. Nothing in the preceding sentence shall prohibit the satisfaction of conditions of more than one certificate among various affiliated facilities or certificates subject to a system-wide or all-inclusive 62 charity care condition established by the Commissioner. In determining whether the certificate holder 63 has met the conditions of the certificate pursuant to a plan of compliance, only such direct payments, 64 efforts, or initiatives made or undertaken after issuance of the conditioned certificate shall be counted 65 66 towards satisfaction of conditions.

67 Any person willfully refusing, failing, or neglecting to honor such agreement shall be subject to a 68 civil penalty of up to \$100 per violation per day until the date of compliance.

G. Pursuant to regulations of the Board, the Commissioner may accept requests for and approve 69 70 amendments to conditions of existing certificates related to the provision of care at reduced rates or to 71 patients requiring specialized care or related to the development and operation of primary medical care services in designated medically underserved areas of the certificate holder's service area. H. For the purposes of this section, "completion" means conclusion of construction activities 72

73 74 necessary for the substantial performance of the contract.
