17104384D 1 **HOUSE BILL NO. 1680** 2 AMENDMENT IN THE NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE 3 (Proposed by the House Committee on Agriculture, Chesapeake and Natural Resources 4 on January 25, 2017) 5 6 (Patron Prior to Substitute—Delegate Bloxom) A BILL amend and reenact §§ 28.2-207, 28.2-208.1, 28.2-246, and 28.2-302.4 of the Code of Virginia 7 and to amend the Code of Virginia by adding a section numbered 28.2-203.2, by adding in Article 1 of Chapter 2 of Title 28.2 sections numbered 28.2-208.2 and 28.2-208.3, and by adding a section 8 9 numbered 28.2-1204.3, relating to Marine Resources Commission; advisory committees. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia: 10 1. That §§ 28.2-207, 28.2-208.1, 28.2-246, and 28.2-302.4 of the Code of Virginia are amended and 11 reenacted and that the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 28.2-203.2, by 12 adding in Article 1 of Chapter 2 of Title 28.2 sections numbered 28.2-208.2 and 28.2-208.3, and by 13 14 adding a section numbered 28.2-1204.3 as follows: 15 § 28.2-203.2. Crab Management Advisory Committee. A. There is hereby established the Crab Management Advisory Committee, referred to in this section 16 17 as "the Committee." The Committee shall meet to discuss and make recommendations to the Commission on crab management issues. 18 19 B. The Committee shall consist of 16 members appointed by the Commissioner, two of whom shall be 20 associate commissioners. The Commissioner shall select the 14 citizen members from a list of nominees 21 submitted by organizations representing various fishery user groups. In making his appointments, the 22 Commissioner shall consider citizen members who represent various geographic areas and a diversity of 23 gear use. 24 C. The term of each citizen member shall be for four years, provided that initial appointments shall be five members appointed for three years, five members appointed for two years, and four members 25 appointed for one year. Appointments to fill vacancies shall be made to fill the unexpired term. Once 26 27 appointed, no member shall be removed during his term of membership except for malfeasance, 28 misfeasance, incompetence, or gross neglect of duty. 29 D. Citizen members shall receive no compensation for their services but shall receive reimbursement 30 for actual expenses. The Committee shall meet at the call of the Commissioner. 31 § 28.2-207. Virginia Saltwater Sport Fishing Tournament Advisory Committee. 32 A. The Virginia Saltwater Sport Fishing Tournament Advisory Committee, referred to in this section as "the Committee," is continued and shall hereinafter be known as the Committee. The Committee shall 33 34 assist the Director of the Virginia Saltwater Sport Fishing Tournament, hereinafter referred to as the 35 Director, with the development and operation of tournament programs. 36 B. The Committee shall consist of twelve 12 members appointed by the Commissioner with the 37 approval of the Secretary of Natural Resources. Committee members shall be selected from a list of 38 nominees supplied by the Director. 39 C. The term of office of each member shall be for four years. Initially, four members shall be 40 appointed for two years, four members appointed for three years, and four members appointed for four 41 years. Appointments to fill vacancies shall be made to fill the unexpired term. Once appointed, no 42 member shall be removed during his term of membership except for malfeasance, misfeasance, 43 incompetence, or gross neglect of duty. 44 D. Members shall receive no compensation for their services but shall receive reimbursement for 45 actual expenses. The Committee shall meet at the call of the Director. § 28.2-208.1. Commercial Fishing Advisory Board. 46 A. There is hereby established the Commercial Fishing Advisory Board, which shall hereinafter be 47 known as the Board. referred to in this section as "the Board." The Board shall advise the Commission **48** 49 on the expenditure of those moneys received. 50 B. The Board shall consist of nine members appointed by the Commissioner from a list of nominees 51 submitted by organizations representing commercial fishing interests. The membership shall be representative of the geographic area covered by the commercial fishing license. 52 53 C. The term of each member shall be for three years, provided that initial appointments shall be 54 three members appointed for three years, three members appointed for two years and three members appointed for one year. Appointments to fill vacancies shall be made to fill the unexpired terms term. 55 Once appointed, no member shall be removed during his term of membership except for malfeasance, 56 57 misfeasance, incompetence, or gross neglect of duty. D. Members shall receive no compensation for their services but shall receive reimbursement for 58 59 actual expenses. The Board shall meet at the call of the Commissioner or at least four times yearly.

60 § 28.2-208.2. Finfish Management Advisory Committee.

61 A. There is hereby established the Finfish Management Advisory Committee, referred to in this 62 section as "the Committee." The Committee shall meet to discuss and make recommendations to the 63 Commission on finfish issues.

64 B. The Committee shall consist of 12 citizen members appointed by the Commissioner and one 65 associate commissioner who represents recreational anglers on the Commission. The Commissioner shall 66 select the 12 citizen members from a list of nominees submitted by organizations representing various fishery user groups, including recreational anglers. In making his appointments, the Commissioner shall 67 68 consider geographic and user group representation, including commercial and recreational, industry, 69 and nongovernmental organizations.

70 C. The term of each citizen member shall be for four years, provided that initial appointments shall be four members appointed for three years, four members appointed for two years, and four members appointed for one year. Appointments to fill vacancies shall be made to fill the unexpired term. Once 71 72 appointed, no member shall be removed during his term of membership except for malfeasance, 73 74 misfeasance, incompetence, or gross neglect of duty.

D. Members shall receive no compensation for their services but shall receive reimbursement for 75 76 actual expenses. The Committee shall meet at the call of the Commissioner. 77

§ 28.2-208.3. Shellfish Management Advisory Committee.

78 A. There is hereby established the Shellfish Management Advisory Committee, referred to in this 79 section as "the Committee." The Committee shall advise the (i) Commission on oyster management issues related to the public oyster fishery and (ii) Commission's staff on the annual oyster replenishment 80 program that places shell and seed oysters on public oyster bottoms. 81

B. The Committee shall consist of 18 members appointed by the Commissioner, two of whom shall be 82 83 associate commissioners. One of the commissioners shall serve as chairman of the Committee. The Commissioner shall select the 16 citizen members from a list of nominees submitted by organizations 84 85 representing various fishery user groups. In making his appointments, the Commissioner shall consider persons who represent various geographic areas and a diversity of gear use. 86

87 C. The term of each citizen member shall be for four years, provided that initial appointments shall be six members appointed for three years, five members appointed for two years, and five members 88 89 appointed for one year. Appointments to fill vacancies shall be made to fill the unexpired term. Once 90 appointed, no member shall be removed during his term of membership except for malfeasance, 91 misfeasance, incompetence, or gross neglect of duty.

92 D. Members shall receive no compensation for their services but shall receive reimbursement for 93 actual expenses. The Committee shall meet at the call of the Commissioner. 94

§ 28.2-246. Fishery Resource Grant Advisory Board; membership; duties.

A. The Fishery Resource Grant Advisory Board shall be composed of seven members to be selected 95 96 in the following manner: four members shall be appointed by the Graduate Marine Science Consortium 97 from nominations made by commercial watermen's associations, one member shall be appointed by the Graduate Marine Science Consortium from nominations made by the aquaculture association, one 98 99 member shall be appointed by the Commissioner of the Marine Resources Commission, and one 100 member shall be appointed by the Director of the Virginia Institute of Marine Science. Once appointed, no member shall be removed during his term of membership except for malfeasance, misfeasance, 101 102 incompetence, or gross neglect of duty.

103 B. The Advisory Board shall (i) in cooperation with commercial fishermen and the Consortium, 104 establish, by July I of each year, the priority areas in which grants shall be awarded and (ii) review each application and make its recommendation to the Consortium. 105 106

§ 28.2-302.4. Virginia Recreational Fishing Advisory Board.

A. There is hereby established the Virginia Recreational Fishing Advisory Board, which shall 107 108 hereinafter be known as the Board., referred to in this section as "the Board." The Board shall advise 109 the Commission in the expenditure of moneys received in the Virginia Saltwater Recreational Fishing 110 Development Fund.

111 B. The Board shall consist of nine members selected from a list of nominees by organized groups, 112 clubs, civic organizations or self-nominations and appointed by the Commissioner who are representative of the interests associated with recreational fishing including representatives from organized recreational 113 114 clubs and others interested in recreational fishing. The membership shall be representative of the geographic area covered by the license. 115

116 \overline{C} . The term of office of each member shall be for three years, provided that initial appointments shall be three members appointed for three years, three members appointed for two years and three 117 members appointed for one year. Appointments to fill vacancies shall be made to fill the unexpired term. Once appointed, no member shall be removed during his term of membership except for 118 119 120 malfeasance, misfeasance, incompetence, or gross neglect of duty.

D. Members shall receive no compensation for their services but shall receive reimbursement for 121

122 actual expenses. The Board shall meet at the call of the Commissioner or at least four times yearly. 123

§ 28.2-1204.3. Habitat Management Advisory Committee.

124 A. There is hereby established the Habitat Management Advisory Committee, referred to in this 125 section as "the Committee." The Committee shall advise and make recommendations to the Commission 126 on state-owned bottomland issues, including marina siting criteria, royalties for use of bottomland, and 127 sandy dredged material guidelines but not including oyster leasing policies.

128 B. The Committee shall consist of six citizen members appointed by the Commissioner who have 129 knowledge regarding issues related to the use of state-owned bottomland.

130 C. The term of each citizen member shall be for four years, provided that initial appointments shall 131 be two members appointed for three years, two members appointed for two years, and two members 132 appointed for one year. Appointments to fill vacancies shall be made to fill the unexpired term. Once 133 appointed, no member shall be removed during his term of membership except for malfeasance, 134 misfeasance, incompetence, or gross neglect of duty.

135 D. Members shall receive no compensation for their services but shall receive reimbursement for 136 actual expenses. The Committee shall meet at the call of the Commissioner.

2. That the provisions of §§ 28.2-203.2, 28.2-208.2, 28.2-208.3, and 28.2-1204.3 of the Code of 137 138 Virginia, as created by this act, shall expire on July 1, 2020.
