That § 46.2-804 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows: 11 § 46.2-804. Special regulations applicable on highways laned for traffic. 12 13 For the purposes of this section, "traffic lines" includes any temporary traffic control devices used to 14 emulate the lines and markings in subdivisions 6 and 7. Whenever any roadway has been divided into clearly marked lanes for traffic, drivers of vehicles 15 16 shall obey the following: 1. Any No vehicle proceeding at less than the normal speed of traffic at the time and place and 17 under the conditions existing, shall be driven in the lane nearest the right left edge or right left curb of 18 19 the highway when such lane is available for travel except when overtaking and passing another vehicle 20 or in preparation for a left turn or where right lanes are reserved for slow-moving traffic as permitted in 21 this section; 22 2. A vehicle shall be driven as nearly as is practicable entirely within a single lane and shall not be 23 moved from that lane until the driver has ascertained that such movement can be made safely; 24 3. Except as otherwise provided in subdivision 5, on a highway which that is divided into three 25 lanes, no vehicle shall be driven in the center lane except when overtaking and passing another vehicle or in preparation for a left turn or unless such center lane is at the time allocated exclusively to traffic 26 27 moving in the direction the vehicle is proceeding and is signed or marked to give notice of such 28 allocation. Traffic-control devices may be erected directing specified traffic to use a designated lane or 29 designating those lanes to be used by traffic moving in a particular direction regardless of the center of 30 the roadway and drivers of vehicles shall obey the directions of every such device; 31 4. The Commissioner of Highways, or local authorities in their respective jurisdictions, may designate right lanes for slow-moving vehicles and the Virginia Department of Transportation shall post 32 33 signs requiring trucks and combination vehicles to keep to the right on Interstate Highway System 34 components with no more than two travel lanes in each direction where terrain is likely to slow the 35 speed of such vehicles climbing hills and inclines to a speed that is less than the posted speed limit; 36 5. Wherever a highway is marked with double traffic lines consisting of a solid line immediately 37 adjacent to a broken line, no vehicle shall be driven to the left of such line if the solid line is on the 38 right of the broken line, except (i) when turning left for the purpose of entering or leaving a public, 39 private, or commercial road or entrance or (ii) in order to pass a pedestrian or a device moved by human power, including a bicycle, skateboard, or foot-scooter, provided such movement can be made 40 41 safely. Where the middle lane of a highway is marked on both sides with a solid line immediately 42 adjacent to a broken line, such middle lane shall be considered a left-turn or holding lane and it shall be lawful to drive to the left of such line if the solid line is on the right of the broken line for the purpose 43 of turning left into any road or entrance, provided that the vehicle may not travel in such lane further 44 45 than 150 feet; 46 6. Wherever a highway is marked with double traffic lines consisting of two immediately adjacent 47 solid yellow lines, no vehicle shall be driven to the left of such lines, except (i) when turning left or (ii) 48 in order to pass a pedestrian or a device moved by human power, including a bicycle, skateboard, or 49 foot-scooter, provided such movement can be made safely; and 50 7. Whenever a highway is marked with double traffic lines consisting of two immediately adjacent 51 solid white lines, no vehicle shall cross such lines. 52 A violation of the provisions of subdivision 1 is punishable by a fine of \$250.
