10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11	1. That § 18.2-408 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
12	§ 18.2-408. Conspiracy; incitement, etc., to riot.
13	Any person who conspires with others to cause or produce a riot, or directs, incites, or solicits other
14	persons who participate in a riot to acts of force or violence, shall be is guilty of a Class 5 felony.
15	However, any person who conspires with others to cause or produce a riot against, or directs, incites,
16	or solicits other persons who participate in a riot to acts of force or violence against, a
17	law-enforcement officer as defined in § 9.1-101, firefighter as defined in § 65.2-102, volunteer firefighter
18	who is employed by or is a member of a bona fide volunteer fire department, emergency medical
19	services personnel as defined in § 32.1-111.1, or member of the Virginia National Guard or the Virginia
20	Defense Force on official state duty or federal duty under Title 32 of the United States Code is guilty of
21	a Class 3 felony.
22	2. That the provisions of this act may result in a net increase in periods of imprisonment or

23 commitment. Pursuant to § 30-19.1:4, the estimated amount of the necessary appropriation is \$0 24 for periods of imprisonment in state adult correctional facilities and cannot be determined for

25 periods of commitment to the custody of the Department of Juvenile Justice.
