VIRGINIA ACTS OF ASSEMBLY - CHAPTER An Act to amend the Code of Virginia by adding in Title 59.1 a chapter numbered 38.2, consisting of sections numbered 59.1-466.5, 59.1-466.6, and 59.1-466.7, relating to limitations on reselling tickets on an Internet ticketing platform; civil penalty. Approved Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia: 1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding in Title 59.1 a chapter numbered 38.2, consisting of sections numbered 59.1-466.5, 59.1-466.6, and 59.1-466.7, as follows: CHAPTER 38.2. TICKET RESALE RIGHTS ACT. § 59.1-466.5. Definitions. As used in this chapter, "event" means any professional concert, professional sporting event, or § 59.1-466.6. Ticket resale limitations; prohibition; exception. A. No person that issues tickets for admission to an event shall issue any such ticket solely through a B. No person shall be discriminated against or denied admission to an event solely on the basis that C. This section shall not apply to (i) student tickets issued for an event at an auxiliary enterprise § 59.1-466.7. Enforcement; penalties. A. The Attorney General may cause an action to be brought in the name of the Commonwealth to C. In an action brought under this section, the Attorney General may recover reasonable expenses D. Whenever the Attorney General has reasonable cause to believe that any person has engaged in,
