That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding in Article 1 of Chapter 27 of Title 54.1 a 13 section numbered 54.1-2708.4 and by adding in Article 2 of Chapter 29 of Title 54.1 a section 14 15 numbered 54.1-2928.2 as follows: § 54.1-2708.4. Board to adopt regulations related to prescribing of opioids. 16 17 The Board shall adopt regulations for the prescribing of opioids, which shall include guidelines for: 18 1. The treatment of acute pain, which shall include (i) requirements for an appropriate patient 19 history and evaluation, (ii) limitations on dosages or day supply of drugs prescribed, (iii) requirements 20 for appropriate documentation in the patient's health record, and (iv) a requirement that the prescriber 21 request and review information contained in the Prescription Monitoring Program in accordance with 22 § 54.1-2522.1; 23 2. The treatment of chronic pain, which shall include, in addition to the requirements for treatment 24 of acute pain set forth in subdivision 1, requirements for (i) development of a treatment plan for the 25 patient, (ii) an agreement for treatment signed by the provider and the patient that includes permission 26 to obtain urine drug screens, and (iii) periodic review of the treatment provided at specific intervals to 27 determine the continued appropriateness of such treatment; and 28 3. Referral of patients to whom opioids are prescribed for substance abuse counseling or treatment, 29 as appropriate. 30 54.1-2928.2. Board to adopt regulations related to prescribing of opioids and buprenorphine. 31 The Board shall adopt regulations for the prescribing of opioids and products containing buprenorphine. Such regulations shall include guidelines for: 32 33 1. The treatment of acute pain, which shall include (i) requirements for an appropriate patient 34 history and evaluation, (ii) limitations on dosages or day supply of drugs prescribed, (iii) requirements 35 for appropriate documentation in the patient's health record, and (iv) a requirement that the prescriber 36 request and review information contained in the Prescription Monitoring Program in accordance with 37 § 54.1-2522.1; 38 2. The use of buprenorphine in the treatment of addiction, including a requirement for referral to or 43 44 consultation with a provider of substance abuse counseling in conjunction with treatment of opioid dependency with products containing buprenorphine. 45 46 2.
