| 14     | A. No contract for the sale or lease of consumer goods or services shall contain a provision           |
| 15     | requiring a consumer to waive his right to make any statement regarding his experience with the seller |
| 16     | or lessor or its employees or agents or concerning the consumer goods or services. Any such provision  |
| 17     | so contained is void and unenforceable.  |
| 18     | B. Any waiver of the provisions of this section shall be deemed to be against public policy and void.  |
| 19     | C. This section shall not apply to any consumer statement regarding the consumer's experience with     |
| 20     | the seller or lessor or its employees or agents or concerning the consumer goods or services made with |
| 21     | the knowledge that it is false or with reckless disregard for whether it is false.                     |
