2 3 Celebrating the life of the Honorable Thomas Graham Baker, Jr. 4

5 6 WHEREAS, the Honorable Thomas Graham Baker, Jr., who served the Dublin community as town 7 attorney and represented the residents of Southwest Virginia in the Virginia House of Delegates for 10 8 years, died on April 15, 2016; and

9 WHEREAS, born in Radford and raised in Draper, the Honorable Thomas "Tommy" Graham Baker, Jr., earned a bachelor's degree from Radford College and law degree from Washington and Lee 10 University; and 11

WHEREAS, Tommy Baker served as the town attorney of Dublin for almost 20 years, then ran for 12 13 and was elected to the Virginia House of Delegates; he ably represented the residents of Pulaski County, part of Giles County, and the City of Radford in the 7th District from 1990 to 1999; and 14

WHEREAS, as a member of the Virginia House of Delegates, Tommy Baker introduced and 15 supported many important pieces of legislation to benefit all Virginians and worked to build consensus 16 on significant issues; he offered his expertise to several committees and commissions and finished his 17 career as chair of the House Committee for Courts of Justice; and 18

19 WHEREAS, Tommy Baker was deeply dedicated to serving the best interests of the people of 20 Southwest Virginia, and he supported many regional projects and helped create Virginia's First Regional Industrial Facility Authority, which established the New River Valley Commerce Park in Dublin; and 21

22 WHEREAS, in addition to his public service, Tommy Baker practiced law with a private firm for 23 many years and inspired students as an educator with the paralegal program at New River Community 24 College: and

25 WHEREAS, throughout his career, Tommy Baker served the Southwest Virginia community and the 26 entire Commonwealth with the utmost dedication and distinction; and

27 WHEREAS, Tommy Baker enjoyed fellowship and worship with the congregation of Draper United 28 Methodist Church: and

WHEREAS, Tommy Baker will be fondly remembered and greatly missed by his parents, Betty and 29 30 Thomas; his son, Jefferson; and numerous other family members, friends, and colleagues on both sides 31 of the aisle; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED by the House of Delegates, the Senate concurring, That the General Assembly hereby 32 33 note with great sadness the loss of the Honorable Thomas Graham Baker, Jr., a public servant in 34 Southwest Virginia; and, be it
