18 WHEREAS, John Kelly has demonstrated a spirit of community service and dedication to public19 safety that is core to the mission and integrity of the Purcellville Police Department; and

WHEREAS, all members of the Purcellville Police Department are thankful for John Kelly's
 professionalism, loyalty, and service over the past four decades, and his colleagues across law
 enforcement will miss him greatly; and

WHEREAS, in retirement, John Kelly will remain active in the western Loudoun community in
which he lives, and he looks forward to spending more time with his wife, Patty, without whose support
his long career would not have been possible; now, therefore, be it
